Drivers in Fort Worth and Irving should be prepared for traffic delays thanks to construction closures this weekend.

On westbound Texas 183 in Irving, lane and ramp closures will take place between Chemsearch Boulevard to MacArthur Boulevard. The main lanes of Texas 183 will be moved onto new pavement.

The work will begin Friday 9 p.m. and run through 6 a.m. Monday.

Here's information on specific closures:

Mainlanes: Westbound Texas 183 from the Texas 114/183 split to MacArthur Blvd. will be reduced to one lane.

Ramps: The westbound Texas 183 ramp from Wingren Road and MacArthur Boulevard will be closed.

In Fort Worth, a portion of Interstate 35W will close all weekend. The northbound lanes will be closed between Western Center Boulevard and U.S. 81/287 from 9 p.m. Friday until 6 a.m. Monday.

Traffic will be detoured to the frontage road at Western Center Boulevard. Drivers will be able to get back onto the mainlanes of I-35W at Heritage Trace Parkway.
