2 major road closures this weekend on North Tarrant Express



The North Tarrant Express will close Precinct Line Road and Holiday Lane in both directions for bridge demolitions this weekend.

Two major roads will be shut down this weekend in North Richland Hills and Hurst for the final North Tarrant Express bridge demolitions.

These sections of old highway lanes will be replaced with new bridges as part of the \$2.5 billion NTE project.

North and south bound lanes of Precinct Line Road will be closed at the junction with Highway 183/121 in Hurst from 9 p.m. Friday to 5 a.m. Monday. Drivers will be redirected to Hurstview Drive and Bedford Euless Road.

To the west in Hurst, Holiday Lane will be shut down in both directions at the junction with Loop 820.

Traffic will be redirected to Rufe Snow Drive and Grapevine Highway (Highway 26).

The project is 71 percent complete and is expected to be completed by June 2015.

The finished project will include free lanes and managed toll lanes where the price changes based on traffic demand.
