ROLLING FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES ON I-35W DURING DAY ON MAY 21 & 22

Rolling closures also on eastbound and westbound Belknap/Weatherford Streets (SH 121)

FORT WORTH, Texas – Drivers in Fort Worth need to take note: there will be rolling full freeway closures on northbound and southbound I-35W between 1st Street and 4th Street from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m.** on **Saturday, May 21 and Sunday, May 22.** There will also be rolling full freeway closures on eastbound and westbound E. Belknap/E. Weatherford Street (SH 121) at I-35W.

These daytime closures are occurring at the request of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) so that Oncor can safely relocate a transmission utility line via helicopter over I-35W to limit impacts to the traveling public.

This work is weather permitting. **Updated closure information is posted daily** on Twitter (onreses) and Facebook (facebook.com/northtarrantexpress)

This work is part of the \$1.4 billion North Tarrant Express 35W project. This includes a section that is currently ranked number six on the state's most congested roadway list along 6.5 miles of I-35W from north of I-30 to north of I-820 including the I-35W/I-820 interchange in Fort Worth. The project includes the reconstruction of main lanes and the addition of TEXpress managed lanes.
