**TRAFFIC IMPACTS ON EASTBOUND LOOP 820/AIRPORT FREEWAY IN THE  
MID-CITIES SATURDAY NIGHT**

**FORT WORTH, Texas – On Saturday, April 30 through Friday, May 3 from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. nightly, the following closures will be in place:**

- All lanes eastbound I-820/SH 121/SH 183 general purpose lanes from Davis Boulevard to Precinct Line Road will be temporarily reduced to one lane.
- All lanes of the eastbound SH 121/SH 183 TEXpress lanes from Texas Boulevard 26 to Bedford Euless Road will be closed.
  - Traffic will be maintained using the general purpose lanes.
- The direct connector from northbound I-820 to the eastbound SH 121/183 TEXpress lanes will be closed.
- The left lane of the direct connector from northbound I-820 to eastbound SH 121/183 will be closed.

*Closures are subject to weather conditions and may be postponed as necessary. All closures might not be implemented at the same time.*

This work is part of the North Tarrant Express Capacity Improvements Project. This 10-mile section of I-820 and SH 121/183 Airport Freeway spans across six cities and will consist of improvements with the addition of one additional general purpose lane in each direction along Loop 820 and one additional TEXpress lane in each direction along SH 121/183.

As with the original corridor that opened in 2014, the North Tarrant Express corridor is owned by TxDOT, but NTE Mobility Partners provides 24/7 operations and maintenance for the corridor (general purpose and managed lanes) including all ramps and bridges.
