NTE CAPACITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO HOST NATIONAL WORK ZONE AWARENESS WEEK EVENT TO HIGHLIGHT SAFETY

FORT WORTH, Texas – On **Tuesday, April 16th at 11:30 a.m.**, North Tarrant Infrastructure (NTI) will host a press conference to promote Work Zone Awareness Week (April 15-19).

This annual event, which emphasizes the importance of staying safe in the work zone for both workers and motorists, will take place in the Cabela's parking lot adjacent to the I-35W service road at SH170 (12901 Cabela's Drive, Fort Worth, TX 76177).



Representatives from NTI, as well as Buyers Barricades, a project partner on the front line of traffic control, will discuss the critical importance of safety in road construction work zones for workers and motorists.
